Re: Lee G. Lovett

As a Canadian attorney who specializes in immigration laws and who was once a Canadian Immigration Officer, I have represented Mr. Lovett (Lee), and known him and his wife, for over twenty years. I have read some of the false and outrageously negative things have been posted on the Internet about Lee. I have personal knowledge concerning some of those accusations on which I comment below.

In particular, I comment on False Accusation 7: "Lee is 'wanted' by the U.S. or other governments" and also on Accusation (8): "Lee was implicated in plots to (a) assassinate public officials and (b) steal Russian oil."

If there were any truth to those outrageous charges, I would know it, because, on multiple occasions, some within the past several years, I have helped the Lovett's obtain residency and visa-related documents for various places. As part of the application process, Mr. Lovett has been repeatedly subjected to worldwide Interpol checks. If he were "wanted" by governments or if there were any truth to the accusations, the Interpol checks would have exposed them, and I would be aware of such allegations. In sum, *the above-charges are false and ludicrous.*

Unfortunately, the Internet lends itself to such tragic defamation of character to which there is no defense or recompense, where the posting-party is judgment proof. The victim can only do as Lee is now doing, namely, post the truth somewhere online. The fact is that Mr. Lovett has led a very proper and accomplished life, as his resume and website manifestly demonstrate, and as I have witnessed for many years. I am therefore pleased to assist in his appropriate rebuttal.
